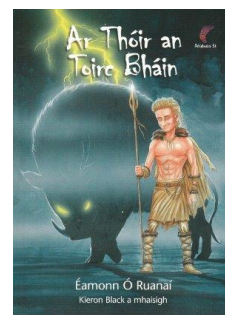

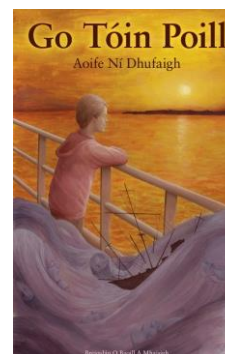

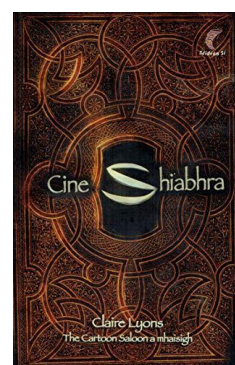


Cine Shiabhra - Claire Lyons (Author), The Cartoon Saloon (Illustrator)

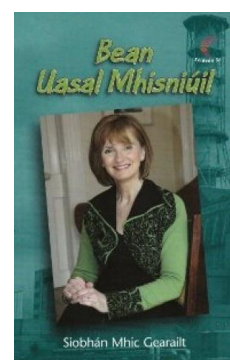
Bean Uasal Mhisniúil (Adi Roche) - Siobhan Mhic Gearailt [Seideán Sí series]

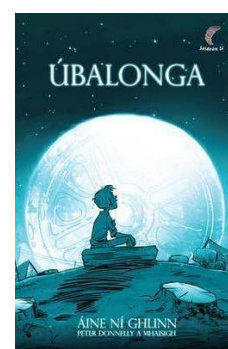
Úbalonga Áine Ní Ghlinn [Seideán Sí series]

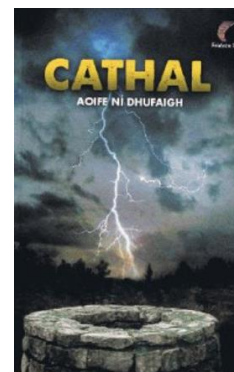
Cathal - Aoife Ní Dhufaigh [Seideán Sí series]
