

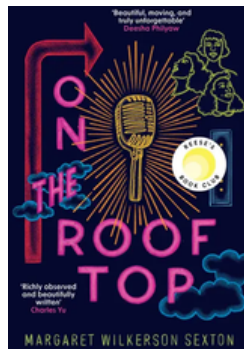

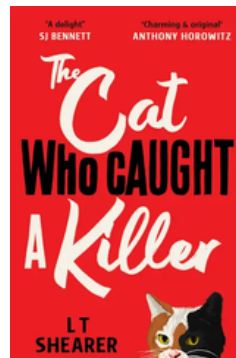
## Kerry Library Book Clubs - the online option

## Getting started with Online Book Clubs

Can the library organise a zoom meeting for our Book Club?

Yes! You can organise your meeting independently of the library or the library can facilitate a zoom meeting for you to help get you started. Just let us know when your Book Club would like to meet and we will do our best to accommodate you. We will need an email address for one or all members of the Book Club and will then set up a link for the zoom meeting which we will email to you. A library staff member will sit in on your first meeting.

### How do I use BorrowBox?

All members of the Book Club will need to be a library member and download the BorrowBox app. They will need a library card number and 4 digit PIN to download an item from BorrowBox.
